He co-managed the development of a mediation advocacy program for the American Bar Association National Institute.

While co-chair of the American Bar Association, Section of Dispute Resolution, Cliff was instrumental in launching the inaugural International Chamber of Commerce Commercial Mediation Competition in Paris, France for national and international law schools. He is also a past Chair of the ABA National Institute on Advanced Mediation and Advocacy Skills Training.

In 2008 Cliff co-found the Canadian National Mediation Advocacy Competition and its successor, the International Mediation Advocacy Competition both of which were designed to encourage law schools throughout the world to teach students enhanced skills for representing clients in mediation.
